Week ending: September 17, 1975

This week the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System has released a revision of money stock measures and related data incorporating benchmark data from the April 16, 1975 call report and reports from foreign agencies and branches. These revisions affect weekly and monthly Ml data back through January 1975. In addition, minor revisions were incorporated into the M2 (Ml plus net time deposits) data back to October 1974. All data on money stock and related items in this release are on the newly revised basis.

The reported money stock data since the first of the year have been lowered by these revisions. For example, the average level of the money stock for the four weeks ended September 3 is \$294.6 billion, compared to \$295.6 billion reported the previous week. As a result, rates of change in the growth of the money stock have been lowered slightly. Using the revised data, the annual growth rate of money over the year ended September 3 is 5 percent, compared to 5.3 percent on the old basis. The reduction in this growth rate reflects the fact that the revision lowered the level of the money stock since the first of the year by about \$1 billion and the 1974 levels were unchanged. Growth rates of money using the old series and the new series are essentially the same for the last six months and the last three months of this year.


Most commercial banks increased their prime lending rate, the rate charged by commercial banks on short-term loans to large businesses with the highest credit standing, from 7.75 to 8 percent within the past week. This was the fourth increase since mid-July when the prime rate was 7 percent. Other short-term market interest rates, such as the three-month Treasury bill rate and the prime commercial paper rate, have increased in recent weeks more slowly than the prime rate. In the latest week they averaged 150 and 112 basis points below the prime rate, respectively. In contrast, yields on these issues in mid-July averaged 95 and 57 basis points, respectively, below the prime rate.

AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES SEASONALLY ADJUSTED BY THIS BANK



MULTIPLIER 1/2 FEDERAL RESERVE CREDIT 2/2 AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES






MONEY STOCK PLUS NET TIME DEPOSITS AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES

MONEY STOCK AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES SEASONALLY ADJUSTED








SELECTED SHORT-TERM INTEREST RATES

DEMAND DEPOSIT COMPONENT OF MONEY STOCK








