The pattern of interest rate behavior over the last year does not support the common assertion that interest rates rise during periods when the adjusted monetary base and adjusted reserves grow slowly and fall when the rates of growth of these aggregates increase. From late June through October, the monetary base grew at a 5 percent rate and reserves did not increase. As the table below shows, interest rates across maturities of financial assets during this same period fell over 300 basis points. From the end of October through the end of April, except for brief fluctuations, interest rates were relatively unchanged. Throughout this period, the base and reserves grew at very rapid rates of 11.5 and 15.4 percent, respectively.

Over the last two months, the growth of base has continued at the same rapid rate, while reserves have expanded at a rapid 11.3 percent rate. During this period, interest rates have trended upward, with the 3-month Treasury bill rising 85 basis points, the 1-year bill rising 73 basis points and long-term Treasury securities rising 47 basis points.

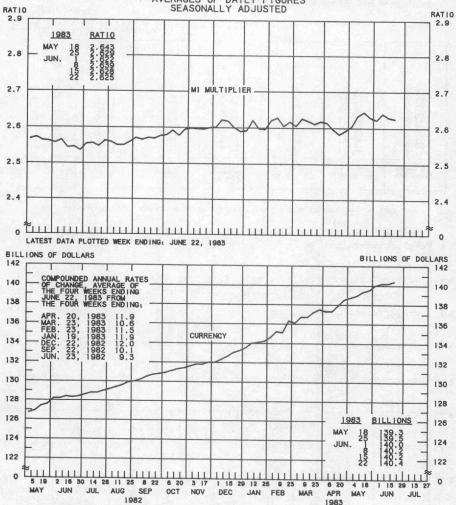

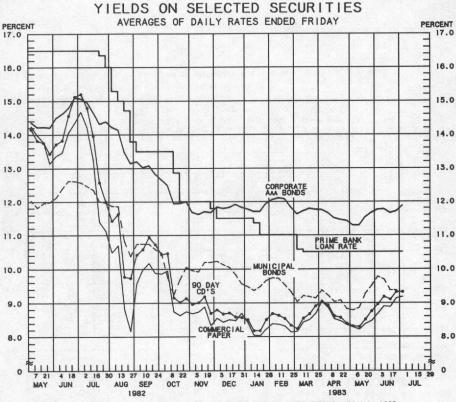
CURRENCY COMPONENT OF MONEY STOCK 2 AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES SEASONALLY ADJUSTED

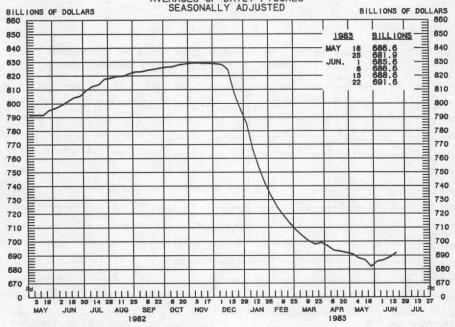

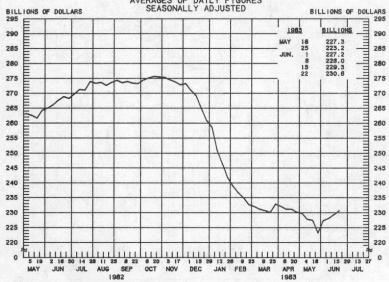
