Recently, the Depository Institutions Deregulation Committee removed most remaining interest rate ceilings on time deposits. On October 1, the ceilings were lifted for all time deposits with original maturities or required notice periods of more than 31 days, and for time deposits in minimum denominations of \$2,500 with original maturities or notice periods of seven to 31 days.

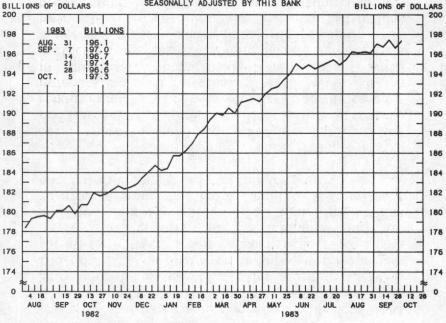
As a result of these actions, the Federal Reserve Board has amended the regulations that determine the reserves financial institutions must hold against deposits. Effective October 1, 1983, the minimum maturity, or required notice period, for all time deposits was reduced from 14 to seven days. The reduction in the minimum maturity of time deposits allows financial institutions to offer a somewhat more liquid deposit without encountering higher reserve requirements.

A second change reduces from 2-1/2 to 1-1/2 years the minimum maturity that qualifies nonpersonal time deposits for a zero reserve requirement. This rule is effective for the reserve computation period beginning October 6, 1983. As in the past, nonpersonal time deposits with maturities less than the minimum are subject to a 3 percent reserve requirement; consequently, the new rule frees reserves that financial institutions previously held against nonpersonal time deposits with maturities between 1-1/2 and 2-1/2 years.

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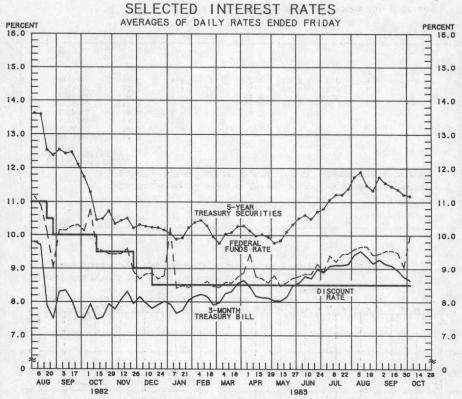
YIELDS ON SELECTED SECURITIES AVERAGES OF DAILY RATES ENDED FRIDAY

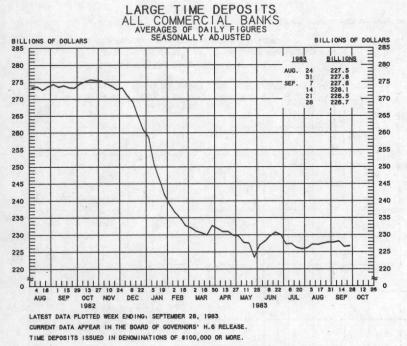
