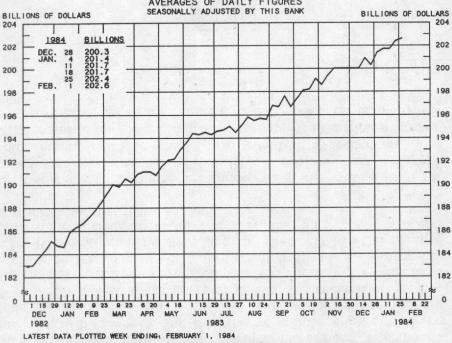
This week marks the introduction of contemporaneous reserve requirements (CRR) for depository institutions that report their deposit and reserve figures weekly to the Federal Reserve System. Under the previously used lagged reserve requirement (LRR) system, depository institutions maintained reserves each week (the "reserve maintenance week") based on deposit levels two weeks earlier (the "reserve computation week"), producing a two-week lag between the beginning of the one-week computation period and the beginning of the one-week reserve maintenance period. Under CRR, the reserve computation and maintenance periods have been lengthened from one to two weeks, and the reserve maintenance period for transaction accounts will begin just two days after the opening of the reserve computation period for transaction accounts. The initial CRR reserve computation period for required reserves on transaction accounts began on Tuesday, January 31, and will end on Monday, February 13, 1984. The initial reserve maintenance period began on Thursday, February 2, and will end on Wednesday, February 15, 1984.

Under CRR, lagged reserve accounting will still be used for non-transaction deposit liabilities subject to reserve requirements and for vault cash counted as reserves. The initial reserve computation period for non-transaction accounts and vault cash began on January 3, and ended on January 16, 1984.

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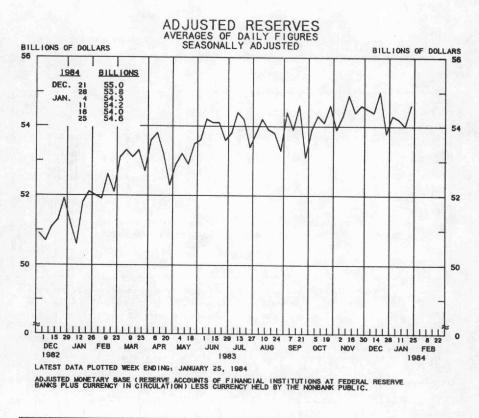

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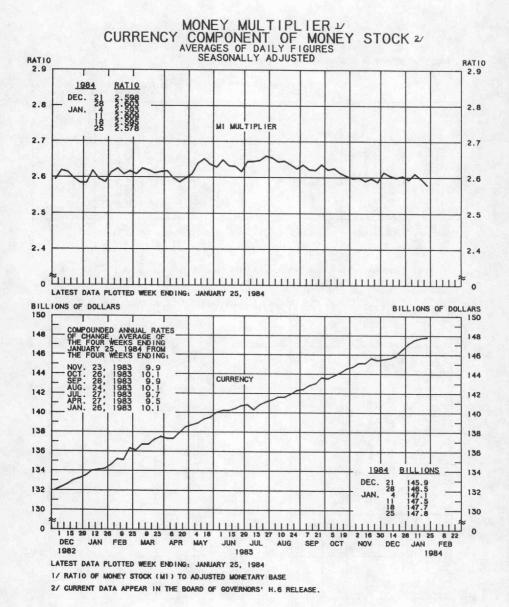

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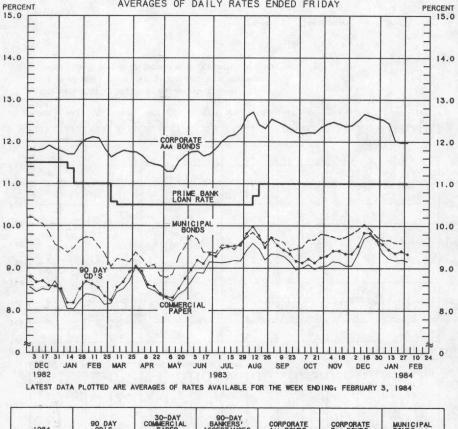

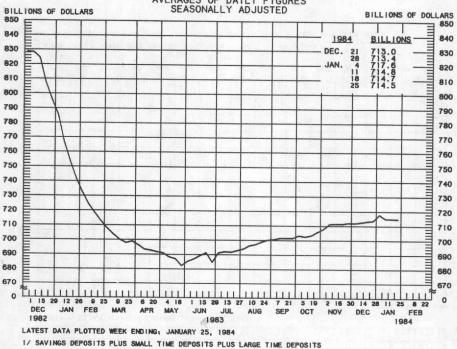

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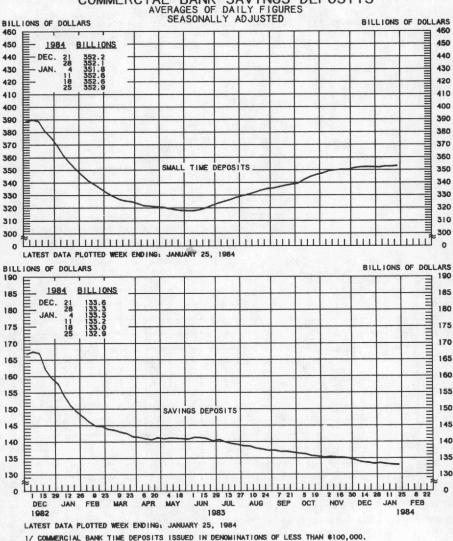
