
The prime rate was reduced from 9 to 8.50 percent April 21. The prime rate has not been this low since mid-June 1978 and, at its current level, is 1300 basis points lower than its peak in December 1980.

The prime rate serves as a benchmark for the interest rate charged by banks on short-term loans to their most creditworthy customers. As such, its level is closely related to the interest cost banks must pay when they borrow funds. For example, the spread between the prime rate and the interest rate on 90-day certificates of deposit averaged about 180 basis points during 1984 and 1985. The previous reduction in the prime rate occurred March 7, 1986, when this spread had reached a level of about 200 basis points. The current reduction followed the week of April 18, 1986, when the spread stood at about 250 basis points.




LATEST PLOTTED RESERVE MAINTENANCE PERIOD ENDING: APRIL 23, 1986


1/ RATIO OF MONEY STOCK (MI) TO ADJUSTED MONETARY BASE




