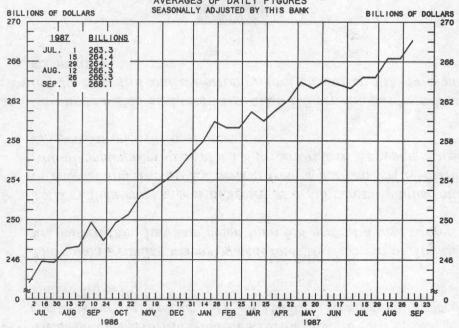

THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Federal Reserve discount rate was raised to 6 percent on September 4, after remaining at 5.50 percent since August 1986. This increase was only the second since May 1981 when the discount rate was 14 percent.
- Yields on long-term government securities rose to 9.73 percent for the week ending September 11, up 118 basis points from the week ending June 19.
- ✓ The nation's civilian unemployment rate was 6 percent in August, unchanged from July and down from 6.8 percent a year earlier.
- Total civilian employment increased at a 3.8 percent annual rate in August and was up 2.7 percent from a year earlier. Nonfarm payroll employment grew at a 1.8 percent rate in August and rose 2.5 percent over the past year.
- Consumer installment credit rose at an 8.5 percent rate from May to July, compared with a 2 percent rate of advance over the previous six months.





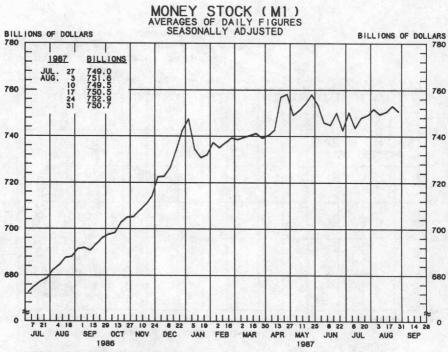

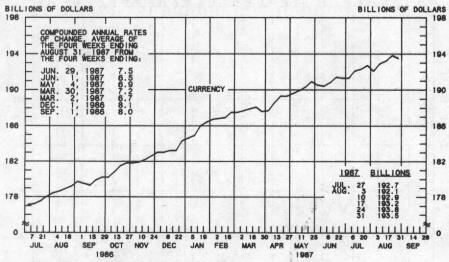

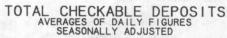

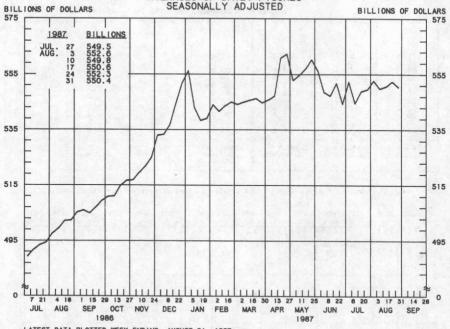

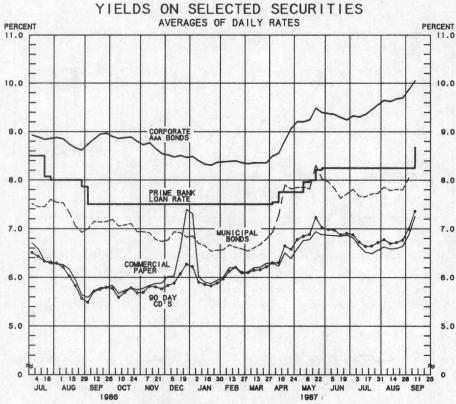

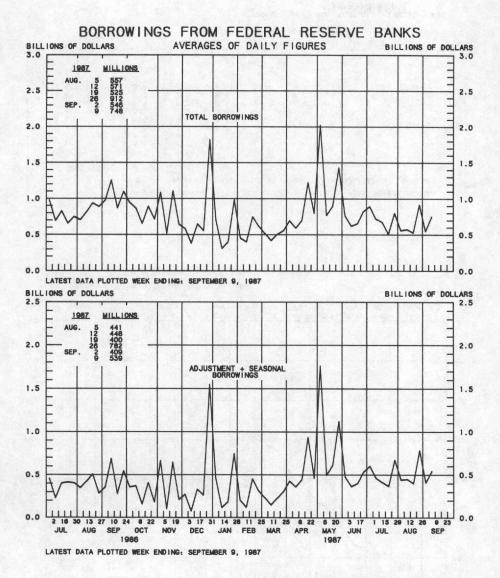

COMMERCIAL BANK TOTAL TIME DEPOSITS AVERAGES OF DAILY FIGURES SEASONALLY ADJUSTED

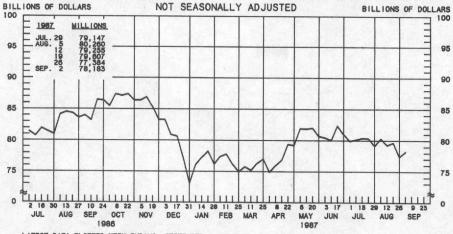

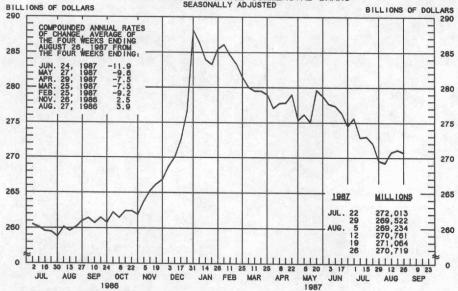
