

## THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ The composite index of leading indicators fell 0.2 percent in October following no change in September. The October drop in the index was attributable primarily to a decline in stock prices and was the first since January 1987.
- Yields on long-term government securities averaged 9.24 percent for the week ending December 4, down from a recent peak of 10.21 percent in mid-October.
- Single-family home sales declined 1.5 percent in October. Through the first 10 months of 1987, sales totaled 593,000, down 9 percent from the same period in 1986.
- Construction spending fell 0.5 percent in October following an increase of 1.5 percent in September. October spending was 3.3 percent above the pace of a year earlier.
- New factory orders for durable goods rose 1.4 percent in October and were up 10.9 percent from October 1986.


























## COMMERCIAL PAPER OF NONFINANCIAL COMPANIES
