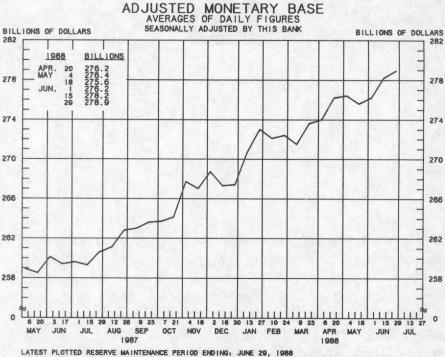


## THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ Short-term interest rates generally have been rising since March of this year (pages 6 and 7). The 30-day commercial paper rate in the past week was 100 basis points above the average level in March.
- Most long-term rates rose from early March through late May but have declined since then. Yields on corporate Aaa bonds in the past week were 21 basis points below the level in late May (pages 6 and 7).
- ✓ The dollar's trade-weighted exchange rate (TWEX) has risen since April of this year, with the most rapid rise occurring since mid-June. The average level of TWEX in the past week was about seven index points above the average level in April (see back page).



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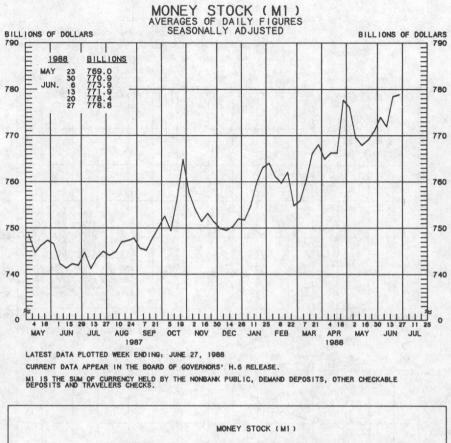
