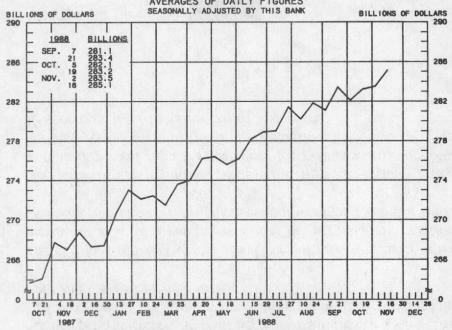

## THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- The trade-weighted value of the dollar fell 7.6 percent from the week ending September 28 to the week ending November 23. For the latest week, the value of the dollar was about the same as a year earlier.
- Consumer prices (CPI) rose at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 5.1 percent in October, up from September's 4.1 percent rate. The CPI has risen at a 4.6 percent rate thus far in 1988, up slightly from the 4.4 percent rise in 1987.
- The CPI food component rose at a 2 percent rate in October, after increasing at an 8.5 percent rate over the previous six months. October food prices were up at a 5.6 percent rate from December 1987.
- New factory orders for durable goods in the August-to-October period were up 2 percent from the average of the previous three months. Durable goods orders in the first 10 months of the year were up 10.4 percent from the same period last year.





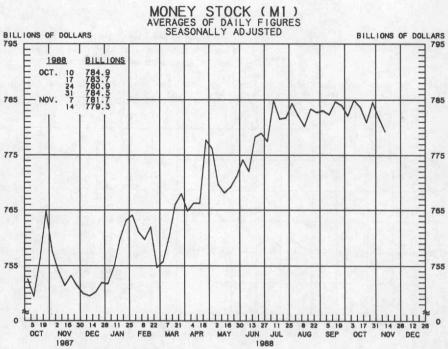


LATEST PLOTTED RESERVE MAINTENANCE PERIOD ENDING: NOVEMBER 16, 1988

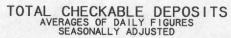

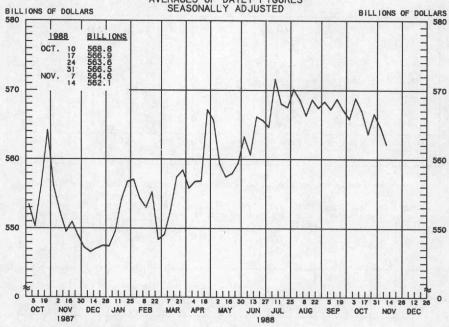

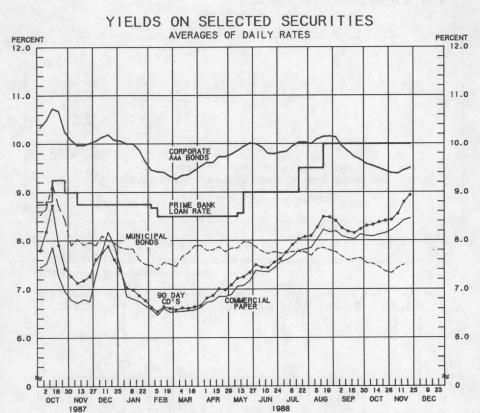

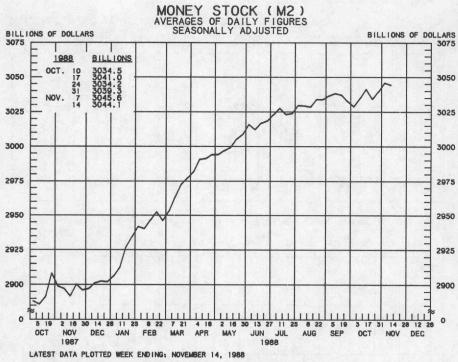

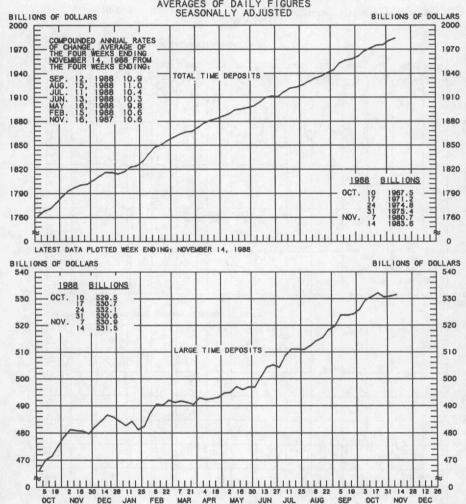

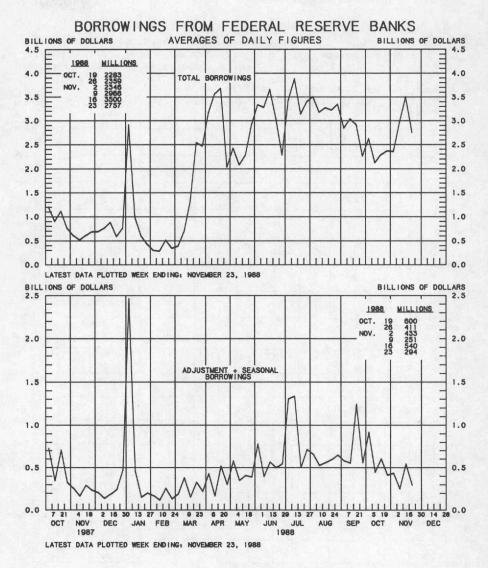

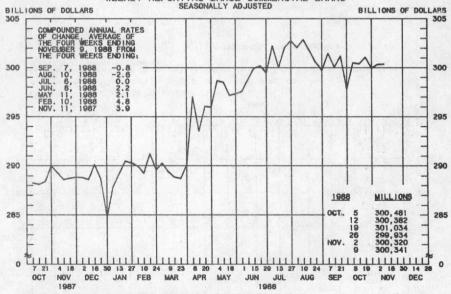


COMMERCIAL PAPER OF NONFINANCIAL COMPANIES

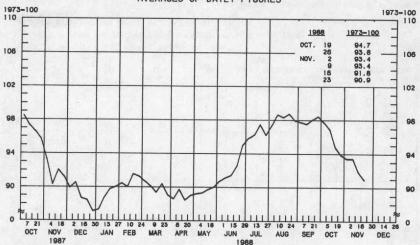
