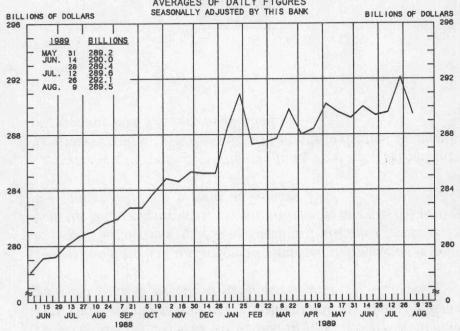

THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- Payroll employment rose 169,000 in July, a 1.9 percent annual rate of increase. Since January, payroll employment has increased at a 2.4 percent rate, down from a 3.3 percent increase in the previous year.
- Total civilian employment fell 82,000 in July, a 0.8 percent rate. Total employment has risen at a 1.3 percent rate since January, down from 2.3 percent growth in the previous year.
- The nation's civilian unemployment rate fell 0.1 percentage point in July to 5.2 percent, reflecting a decline in the labor force greater than the fall in employment. The unemployment rate was 5.4 percent last January and 5.8 percent in January 1988.
- Consumer credit rose \$2.99 billion in June, or at a 5.3 percent rate. Consumer credit increased at a 13 percent rate in the first six months of this year and 8.5 percent in 1988.





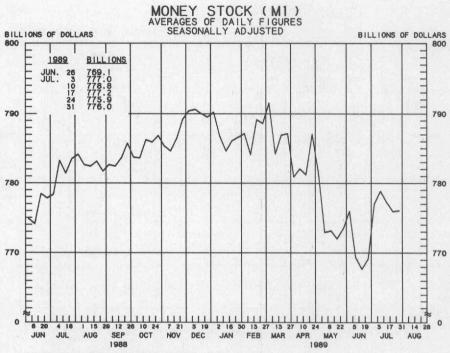

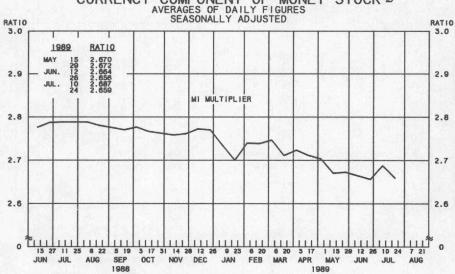

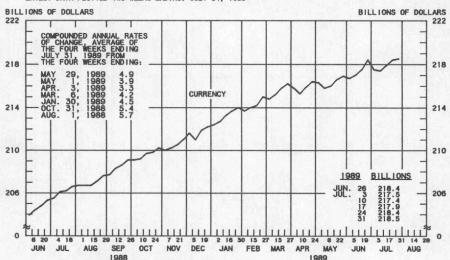

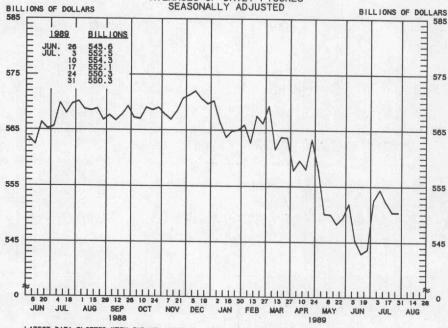

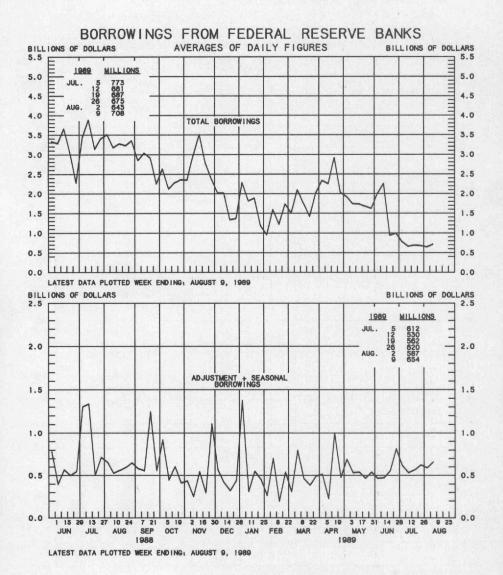




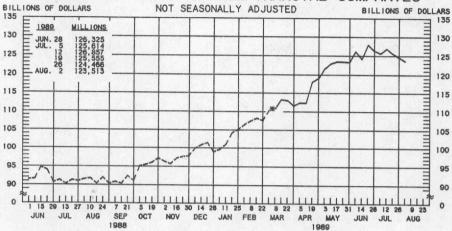

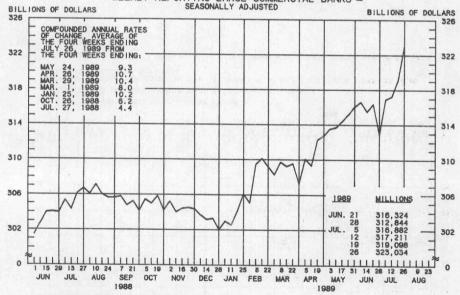

WEEKLY REPORTING LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS 2/

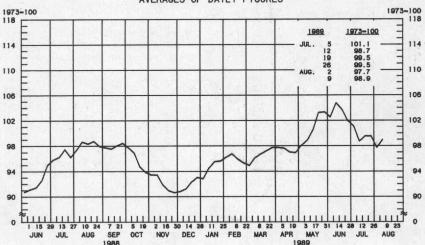
