
THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- Civilian employment fell at a 0.3 percent annual rate over the past three months, following a 1.4 percent rate of increase from March to June, and a 3.1 percent rate of growth over the six months ending last March.
- Unemployment was 5.3 percent of the civilian labor force in September, the same as in June and little changed from the 5.4 percent rate in September 1988.
- Consumer credit rose at a 6 percent annual rate in August, following a decline at a 0.9 percent rate in July. From January to June, consumer credit rose at a 6.8 percent rate.
- Commercial and industrial loans at weekly reporting large commercial banks fell in September, reaching \$318 billion in the week of September 27, slightly below the average level in July.












COMMERCIAL PAPER OF NONFINANCIAL COMPANIES
