

## THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- The M1 money stock has grown at a 3.9 percent annual rate since the four weeks ending May 22, following a decline at a 4.5 percent rate during the previous five months.
- Real GNP expanded at a 2.5 percent annual rate in the third quarter, the same rate as in the previous quarter. Real GNP has increased at a 2.9 percent rate thus far this year, compared with 3.4 percent in 1988.
- The GNP deflator rose at a 2.9 percent annual rate in the third quarter, down sharply from a 4.6 percent rate in the preceding quarter. Thus far this year, the deflator has risen at a 3.8 percent rate, little changed from 4 percent in 1988.
- New factory orders for durable goods fell 0.1 percent in September, after rising 3.9 percent in August. From the fourth quarter of 1988 to the third quarter of this year, durable goods orders have declined 0.6 percent, after rising 12.1 percent in the previous year.







LATEST PLOTTED RESERVE MAINTENANCE PERIOD ENDING: OCTOBER 18, 1989






TOTAL CHECKABLE DEPOSITS




#### COMMERCIAL PAPER OF NONFINANCIAL COMPANIES


