

### THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ The composite index of leading indicators decreased 0.4 percent in October, primarily reflecting a shorter average workweek and an increase in initial state unemployment claims. The index rose 0.3 percent in September and 0.6 percent in August.
- Sales of new single-family houses fell 0.5 percent in October. Through the first 10 months of 1989, new one-family home sales totaled 565,000, down 4.4 percent from the same period last year.
- Construction spending in October rose 1 percent to a \$420.1 billion annual rate, but was down at a 1.2 percent rate from December 1988.
- Productivity in the business sector (including farms) rose at a 1.8 percent annual rate in the third quarter and was up at a 1.4 percent rate from the fourth quarter of 1988.






















