


THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ New factory orders, spurred by large increases in the durable goods sector, rose a seasonally adjusted 3.8 percent in March. Orders for transportation equipment, including a 63 percent increase for aircraft and parts, made the March increase in durable goods orders the largest since December 1988.
- U.S. personal income rose at a 9.7 percent annual rate in March, following a 9.4 percent rate of increase in February. March income was up 7.1 percent from a year earlier.
- ✓ Sales of new single-family homes fell 5 percent in March to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 574,000 units. For the first three months of 1990, single-family home sales of 153,000 units were down 5 percent from the 161,000 units sold during the same period last year.
- The index of leading economic indicators increased 0.9 percent in March after falling 1 percent in February. Six components of the index rose in March, three components declined and two were unchanged.

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
