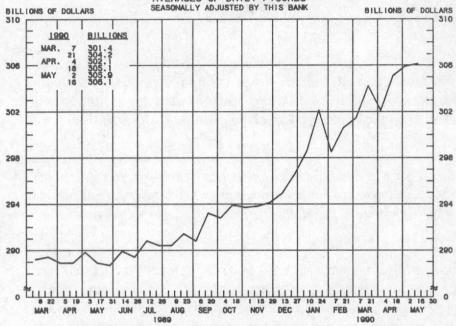

## THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ U.S. industrial production fell at a 4.3 percent annual rate in April, following 6.8 and 11.8 percent rates of increase in March and February. During the past six months, production has increased at a 1.9 percent rate.
- Housing starts fell 5.8 percent in April to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 1,245,000 units, the lowest level since October 1982. Starts have averaged 1,374,000 units at an annual rate over the past six months, down 8.2 percent from the same six-month period a year earlier.
- Consumer prices rose at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 1.9 percent in April, but were up at a 6 percent rate from October 1989. Excluding food and energy, consumer prices were up at a 5.6 percent rate from October.
- Producer prices (PPI) for finished goods fell at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 3 percent in April, but were up at a 4.2 percent rate from last October. Excluding food and energy, the PPI rose at a 3.3 percent rate over the past six months.





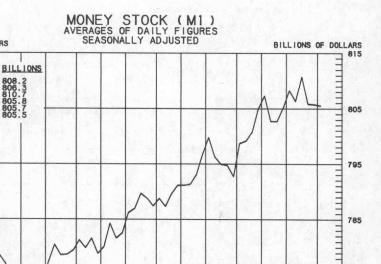

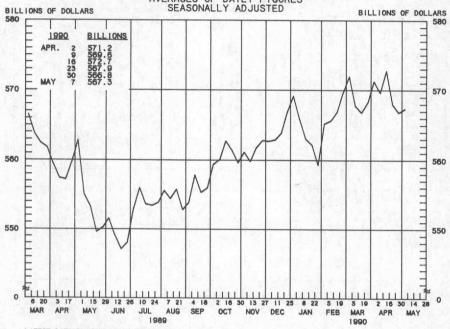

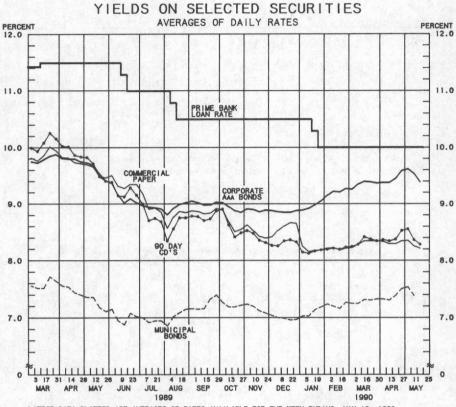

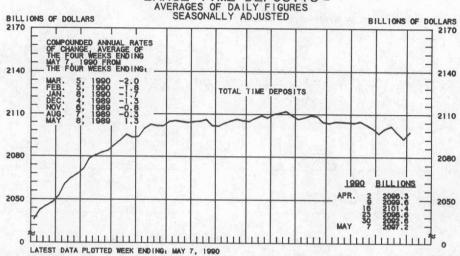

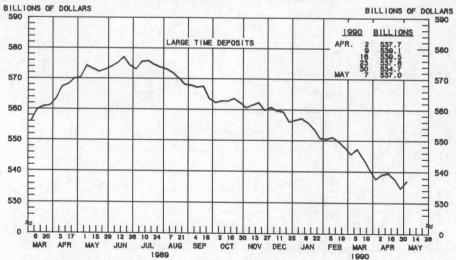

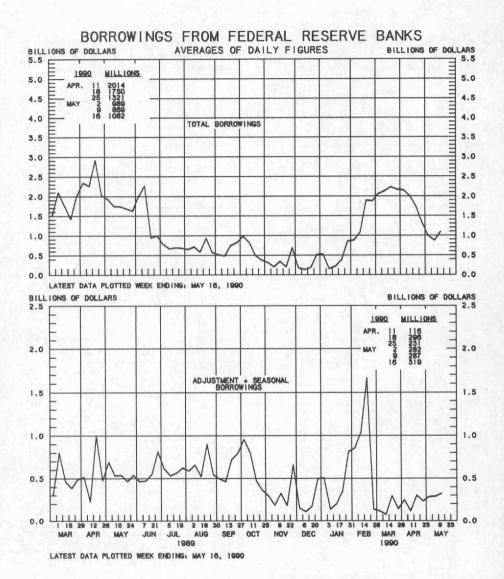

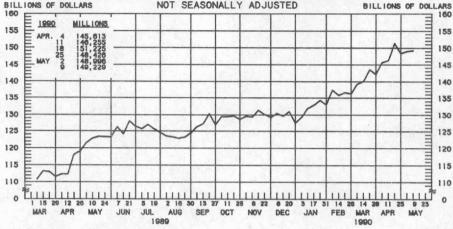

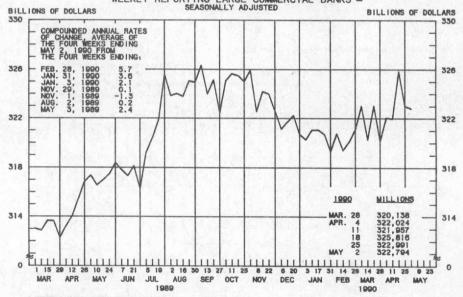

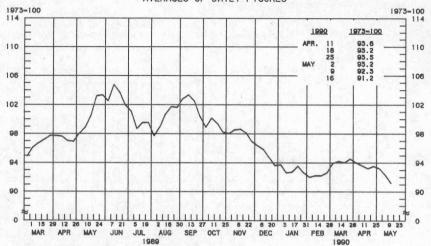
