THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:


Personal income increased at an annual rate of 3.7 percent in April and was up 6.8 percent from a year earlier. Personal income data are not adjusted for inflation.

Real personal consumption expenditures (PCE) rose at a 4.2 percent annual rate in April after declining at a 1.3 percent rate in March. Since April 1989, real PCE has risen 2.5 percent.

- Sales of new single-family homes fell 1.6 percent in April to the lowest pace since December 1982. Sales totaled 206,000 units in the first four months of the year, down 6.8 percent from the same period in 1989.
- ✓ The composite index of leading indicators fell 0.2 percent in April, following a 1 percent increase in March and a 1 percent decrease in February.
- The dollar's trade-weighted exchange rate has risen slightly after falling the previous four weeks. Since September 13, 1989, it has declined 10.6 percent.
















2/ TIME DEPOSITS ISSUED IN DENOMINATIONS OF \$100,000 OR MORE
