THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- Retail sales rose at a 6.6 percent annual rate in June, the first increase since February. Since December of last year, retail sales have risen at a 2.8 rate.
- Industrial production rose at a 5.6 annual rate in June, following a 6.8 rate of increase in May.
- ▶ Housing starts declined 2.3 percent in June, the fifth consecutive monthly decline this year. Housing starts in June were 16.8 percent below the level of a year ago.
- Consumer prices rose at a 6.7 percent annual rate in June, after increasing at a 1.9 percent rate in both April and May. Since December, consumer prices have increased at a 5.9 percent rate.
- The merchandise trade deficit widened to \$7.73 billion in May from a revised \$7.31 billion in April. Thus far this year, the trade deficit has totaled \$40.7 billion, down from \$46.4 billion for the same period in 1989.

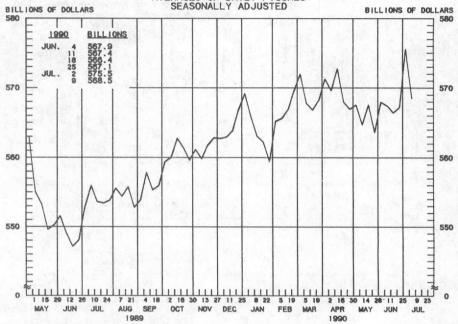

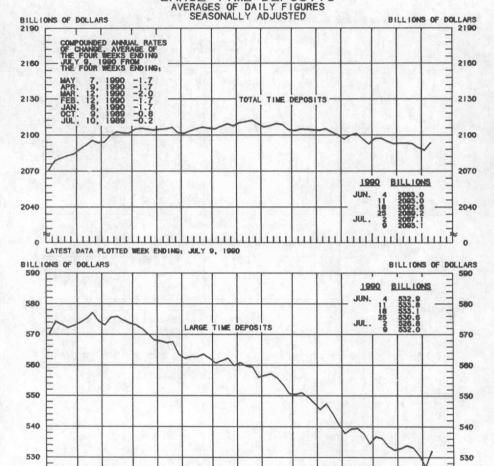

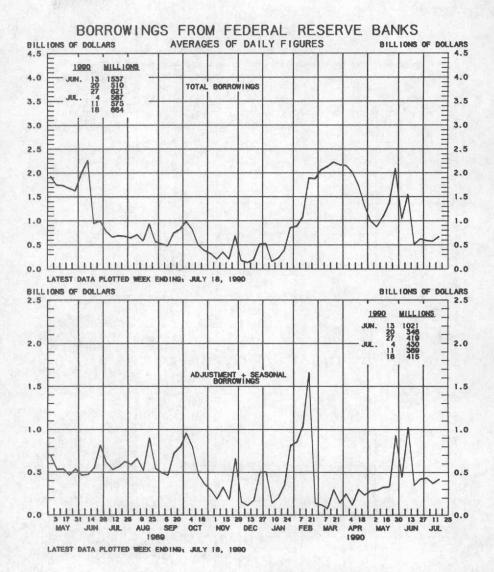

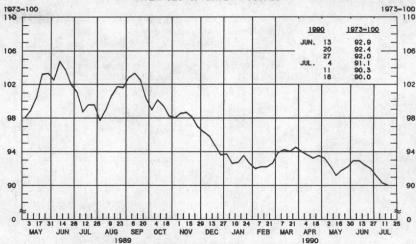
BUSINESS LOANS (COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL)
