

THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ Domestic passenger car sales in May increased at an annual rate of 6.1 million vehicles, up from April's 5.5 million pace, but slightly below March's 6.2 million rate. May's sales were 8.7 percent below those in May 1990.
- ✓ The National Association of Purchasing Managers' index, a measure of manufacturing activity, rose in May for the fourth consecutive month, reaching its highest level since August 1990.
- ✓ The value of new construction in April was \$392.6 billion at an annual rate, up 0.8 percent from March. This was its largest monthly increase since February 1990. April's figure was 11.7 percent below its level in April 1990.
- ✓ Factory orders rose 1.8 percent and factory shipments increased 2.6 percent in April, the first increases in these measures since October 1990.
- ✓ The Commerce Department's index of leading indicators rose 0.6 percent in April, its third consecutive monthly rise.



Adjusted Monetary Base

The adjusted monetary base is the sum of reserve accounts of financial institutions at Federal Reserve banks, currency in circulation (currency held by the public and in the vaults of all depository institutions) and an adjustment for reserve requirement ratio changes. The major source of the adjusted monetary base is Federal Reserve credit. Data are computed by this bank. A detailed description of the adjusted monetary base is available from this bank.



M1 is the sum of currency held by the nonbank public, demand deposits, other checkable deposits and travelers checks.






Money Multiplier^{1/}

Seasonally Adjusted











Total and Large Time Deposits ^{1/}






Money Market Funds

Money Market Deposit Accounts


All Depository Institutions



Adjustment + Seasonal Borrowings





Seasonally Adjusted


