

THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ The growth of the M1 money stock has accelerated at a sharp 13 percent annual rate since September. M1 grew at a 7.1 percent rate during the previous nine months.
- ✓ The consumer price index for all urban consumers (CPI) rose at a 5.4 percent annual rate during November, but has increased at a 2.9 percent rate so far in 1991.
- ✓ Industrial production declined at a 4.3 percent annual rate in November, after little change during the prior three months. A drop in motor vehicle and parts production and a strike at a major producer of construction and mining equipment accounted for much of the November decline.
- ✓ Housing starts declined 2.1 percent in November. For the first 11 months of 1991, units started were 16.5 percent below the number of starts for the same period in 1990.






Latest data plotted week ending: December 18, 1991




