THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- ✓ The yield on three-month Treasury bills averaged 3.07 percent for the week ending May 28. This yield has changed little since January.
- ✓ The yield on long-term Treasury securities averaged 6.72 percent for the week ending May 28, down from 7.24 percent in mid-January.
- ✓ The M2 money stock has declined at a 0.1 percent annual rate since the four weeks ending January 18, 1993. For the five months before the January period, the M2 money stock increased at a 1.5 percent rate.
- ✓ Advance new orders for manufactured durable goods in April increased a slight \$0.1 billion to \$130.3 billion, which follows a revised 3.7 percent decrease in March and a 2.3 percent increase in February. Excluding defense, new orders in April declined \$0.1 billion.
- ✓ The federal budget showed a surplus of \$8.1 billion in April. Seven months into this fiscal year the deficit has totaled \$174.7 billion, down from \$184.8 billion for the same period in fiscal 1992.


Large and Small Time Deposits 1/




