THE WEEK'S HIGHLIGHTS:

- According to the preliminary estimate, output per hour (productivity) in the nonfarm business sector was unchanged in the first quarter after rising at a 2.5 percent annual rate over the last half of 1997. Unit labor costs, however, following a 3.7 percent increase in the fourth quarter of 1997, advanced at a 4 percent rate in the first quarter. Measured from four quarters earlier, productivity has increased 1.8 percent, while unit labor costs are up 2.2 percent.
- Inventories at merchant wholesalers rose 0.5 percent in March. The nominal value of wholesaler inventories rose 1.4 percent in the first quarter, or \$15.4 billion at an annual rate. This increase was \$2.8 billion less than the fourth quarter increase.
- The value of new factory orders for manufactured durable and nondurable goods rose 0.3 percent in March. For the first quarter, however, factory orders fell 0.8 percent, their first decrease in 11 quarters. Factory orders are not adjusted for price changes.
- After rising 0.4 percent in February, the index of leading indicators increased 0.2 percent in March, its eighth gain in the past 10 months.
- Real disposable personal income (DPI) advanced at a 4.3 percent annual rate in March, notably slower than the 6.2 percent rate of increase in purchases by consumers. Measured from a year earlier, real DPI has increased 4.2 percent, while real consumer spending is up 4.1 percent.

All data are seasonally adjusted unless otherwise indicated.


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
Adjusted Monetary Base



The adjusted monetary base is the sum of Federal Reserve deposits and vault cash held by domestic depository institutions, currency held by the public, and an adjustment for the effect of changes in reserve requirement ratios. The monetary base series was recently revised to include Federal Reserve deposits used to satisfy clearing balance contracts. Data are computed by this bank. A detailed description of the adjusted monetary base is available from this bank. Recent data are preliminary.


Money Stock(M1) and Total Checkable Deposits








Currency Component of M1





Money Stock(M2) and Non-M1 Components of M2




M2 is the sum of M1, savings (including money market deposit accounts), small time deposits and retail money funds. Current data appear in the Federal Reserve Board's H.6 release.




Large Time Deposits and Retail Money Funds


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Total Borrowings

Bank Loans and Credit





Commercial and Industrial Loans


