Hopkins appoints Dr. Shanley chairman of Western Regional Advisory Board.

Harry L. Hopkins, Works Progress Administrator, today appointed Dr. T. J. D. Shanley, prominent practicing physician of Butte, Mont., as chairman of the Regional Works Progress Advisory Board for Western States. The board will consist of from three to five members and other members will be appointed later. They will act as observers of the Works Progress Administration operations in the Western States and have been asked to give the Administration the benefit of unbiased, competent advice from an outside point of view.

They will have no administrative duties and will receive no salary except the customary \$25 a day for advisors when actually on Government business. Other regional advisory boards will be appointed later.

The Regional Works Progress Advisory Board for Western States will observe in: Montana, Wyoming, Colorado, New Mexico, Arizona, Utah, Idaho, Washington, Oregon, California, and Nevada.
