More than half of South Dakota's WPA project cost for construction and repair work.

Approximately 60 per cent of the money for Works Progress Administration Projects in South Dakota will be spent for highways, roads and streets, public buildings of all types, parks and playgrounds, flood control and other conservation, water supply and sewer systems and transportation, according to an announcement made today by Harry L. Hopkins, Works Progress Administrator.

A listing by types and cost of projects shows that of the total of \$4,082,223 to be spent, as of December 31, 1935, the following classifications accounted for the largest proportion:

Highways, farm-to-market roads and streets, \$1,508,267 or 36.9 per cent; public buildings, both governmental and educational, \$275,787 or 6.8 per cent; parks and playgrounds, \$149,206 or 3.6 per cent; flood control and other conservation, \$286,021 or 7.0 per cent; water supply and sewer systems, \$249,525 or 6.1 per cent; and, transportation, \$91,138 or 2.2 per cent.

The balance of the money will be spent to provide work for women, white-collar, and other technical and professional unemployed workers.
