President Roosevelt Allocates \$153,096 for Bridge Construction in Maine, Massachusetts and West Virginia.

The President today allocated \$153,096 from the funds of the Emergency Relief Appropriation Act of 1936 to reconstruct or replace bridges damaged or destroyed by floods in Maine and Massachusetts and a new bridge over the Potomac River connecting West Virginia and Maryland.

Maine received an allocation of \$17,700, Massachusetts an allocation of \$60,117, and West Virginia \$75,279.

The projects will be carried on under the supervision of the Bureau of Public Roads, Department of Agriculture. Treasury warrants have been countersigned by the Comptroller General.
