WPA EMPLOYMENT DECLINES TO 1,821,151 DURING LAST WEEK OF JUNE

Administrator Harry L. Hopkins announced today that 1,821,151 workers were employed on projects of the Works Progress Administration during the week ending June 26.

More than 124,000 have left the rolls in two weeks, reports show. Employment totaled 1,945,796 during the week ending June 12.

One week later it had dropped to 1,866,617.
