Slight Decline Shown in WPA Employment for Week Ending September 4.

Administrator Harry L. Hopkins today announced that 1,468,899 workers were employed on projects of the Works Progress Administration during the week ending September 4.

This was a decline of 13,808 from the previous week, when employment totaled 1,482,707. Slight increases were registered during this period in 16 States, New York City and the Territory of Hawaii.

During the last three months, the rolls showed an average weekly decline of nearly 38,000.
