WPA EXPENDITURES FOR MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT TOTAL NEARIY $\$ 700,000,000$

Approximately $\$ 700,000,000$ has been spent in the purchese of materials, euipment and supplies for Works Progress Administration projects in the three years ending June 30, 1938, Acting Administrator Aubrey Williams announced today.

Of the total of $\$ 696,356,000$, exactly one-third went for stone, clay and glass products used principally in building and road construction. Iron and steel products, exclusive of machinery, absorbed. 18.7 percent of the total; lumber and lumber products, 11.2 percent, and bituminous mixtures, principally for paving, 8.2 percent. Other items of which large purchases were made include textiles, machinery and mechanical equipmert, chemical products, oil and gasoline, and plumbing equipment.

The total represents combined expenditures of Federal and sponsors ${ }^{\text {P }}$ funds, Mr. Williams said, the latter accounting for 54 percent of the whole anount throughout the three year period. The proportion of sponsors' funds has increased materially each year, he added, having been 36 percent for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1936, 50 percent in 1937, and 71 percent in 1938.
