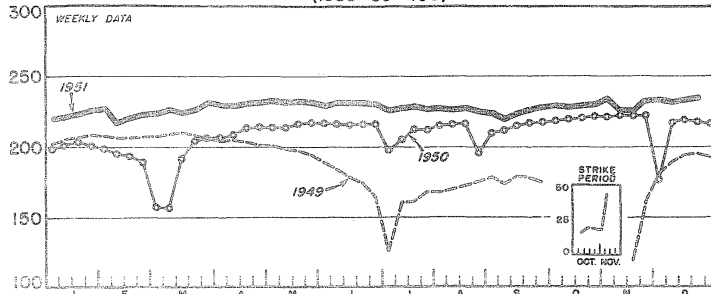

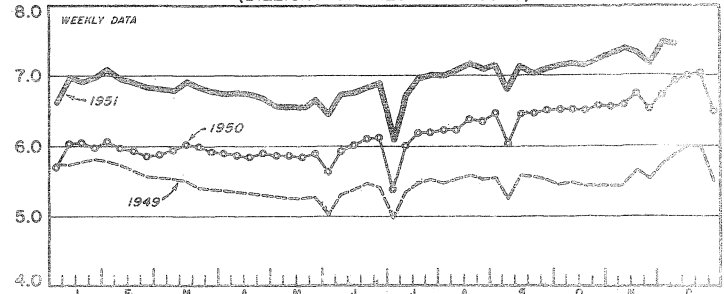

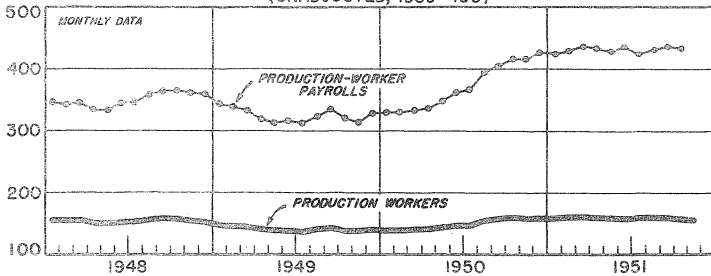
**STEEL PRODUCTION (Ingots and Steel for Castings)**  
(1935-39 = 100)



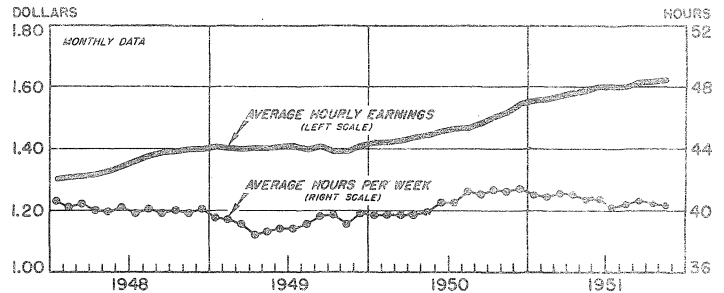
**ELECTRIC-POWER PRODUCTION BY UTILITIES**
