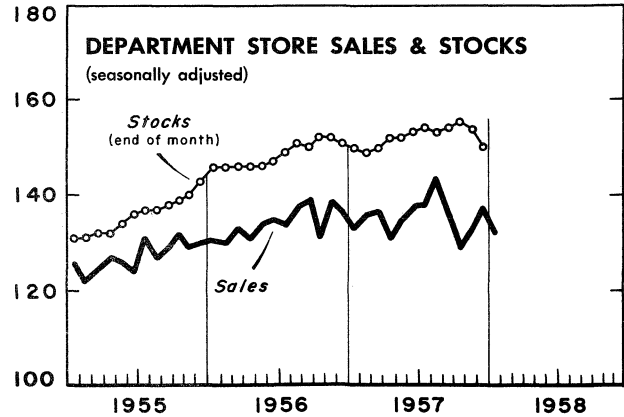

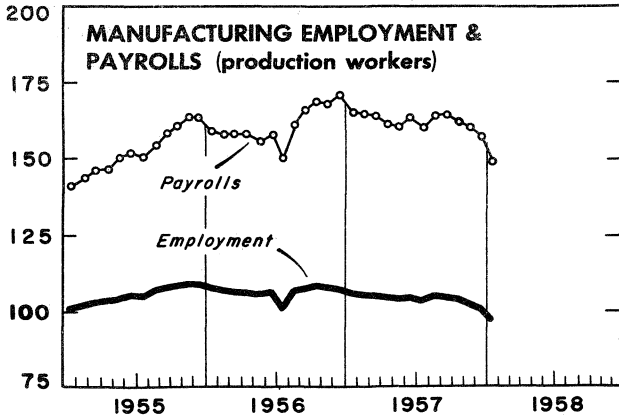
Billion Dollars



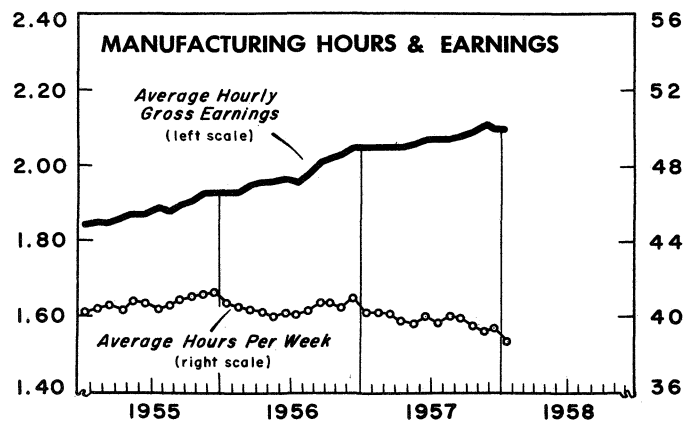
