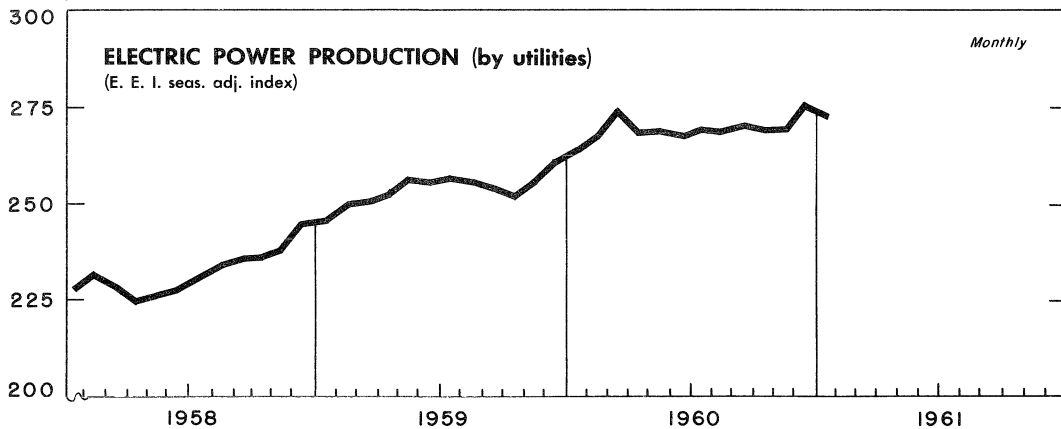

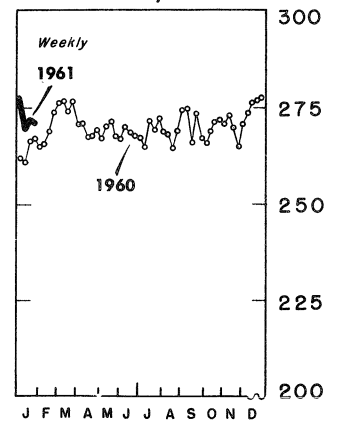

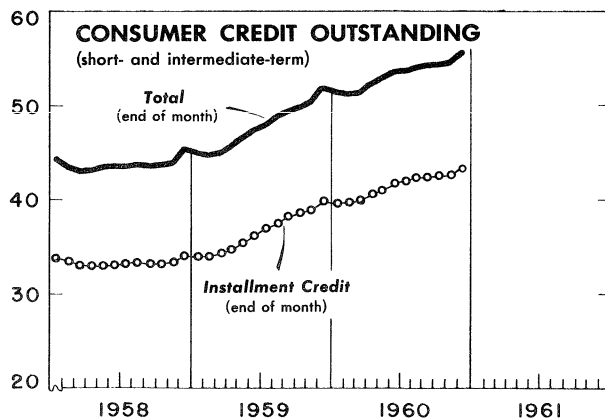
Index, 1947 - 49 = 100



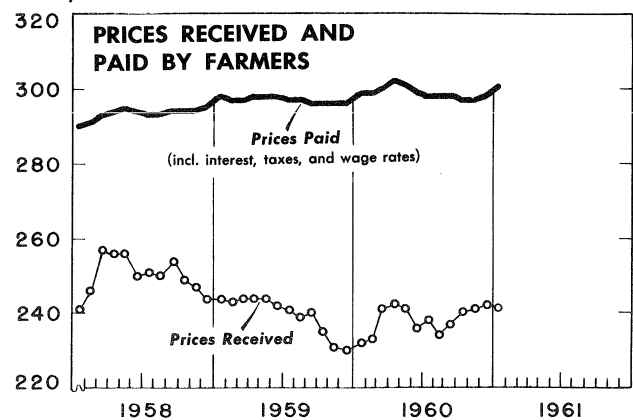
Index, 1947 - 49 = 100
