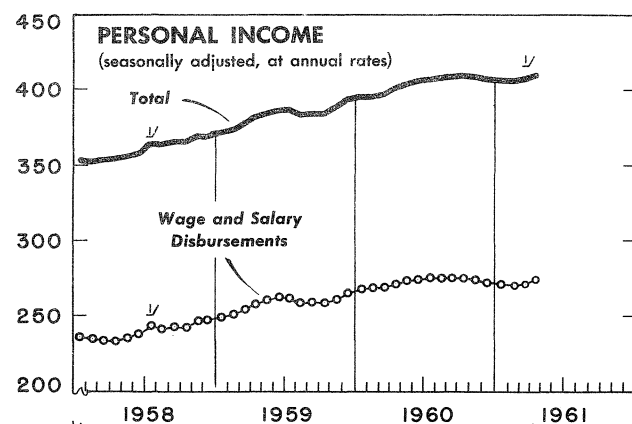
Index, 1947-49=100



Index, 1947-49=100

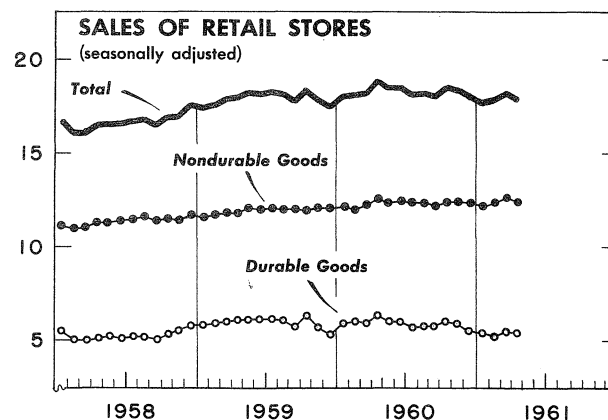


Billion Dollars

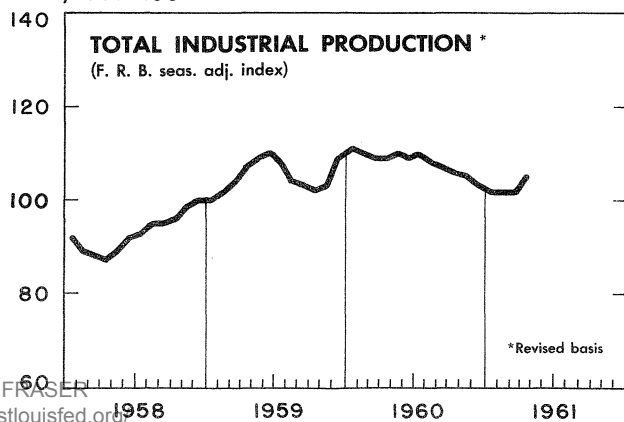

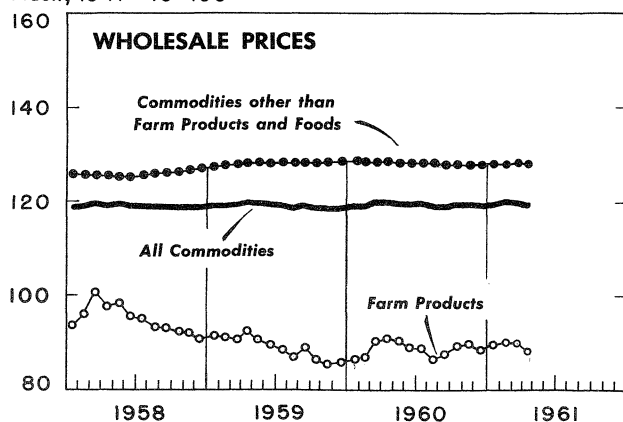
