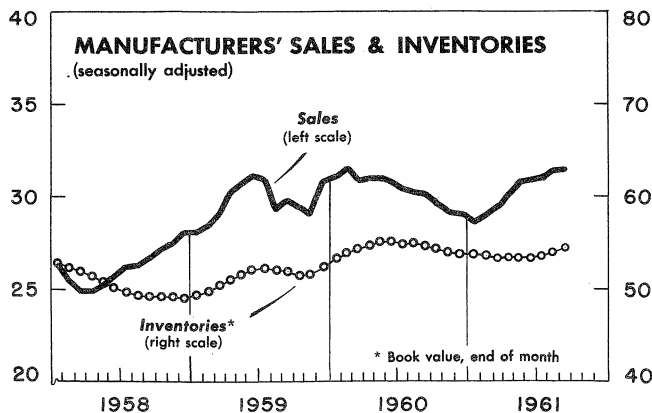
Index, 1947 - 49=100



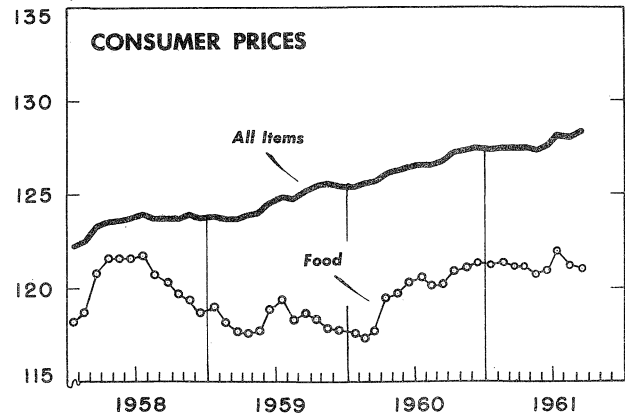
Index, 1957-59=100
