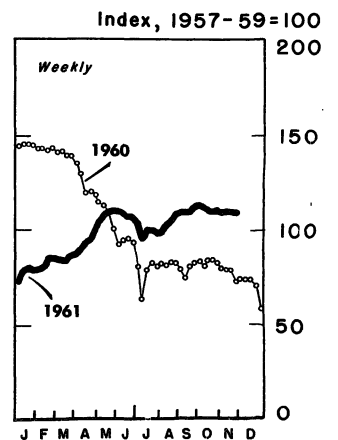
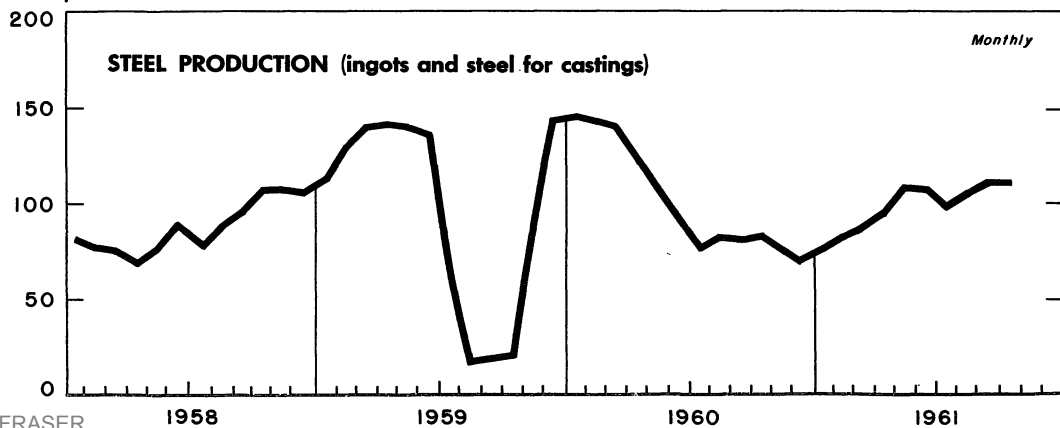
Index, 1947 - 49=100
