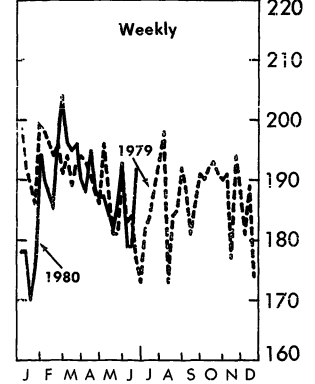

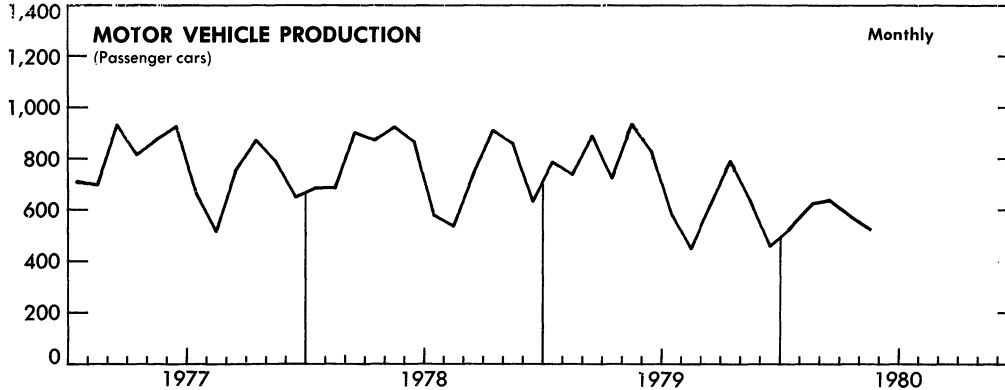

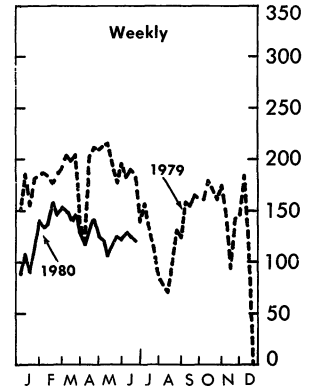

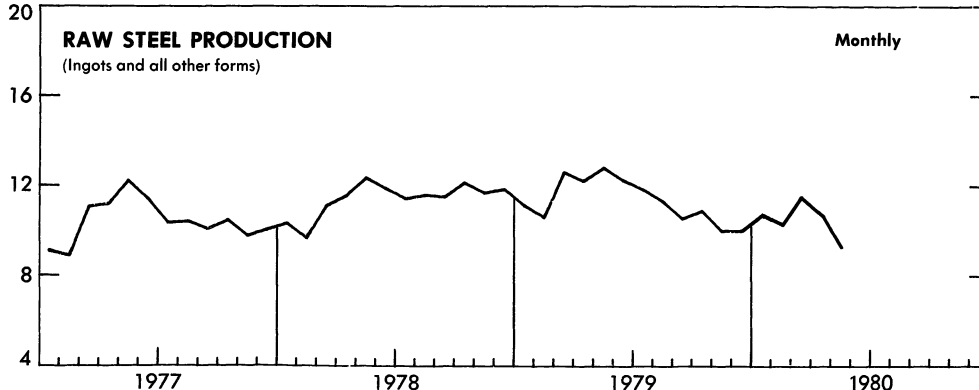

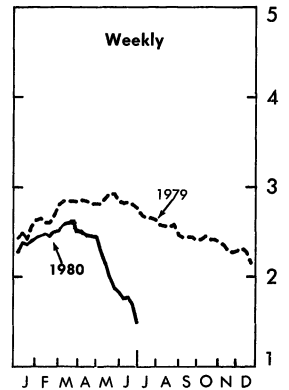


MILLIONS OF SHORT TONS
