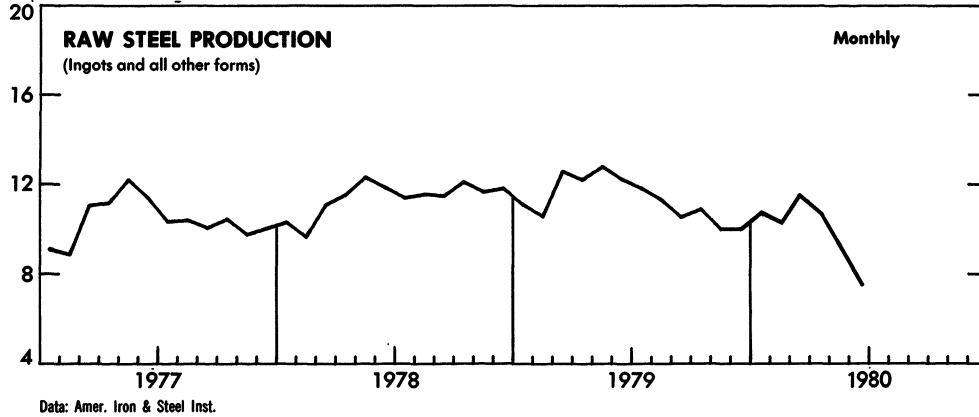

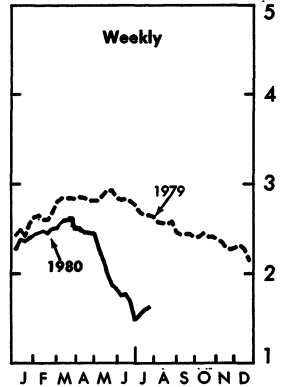

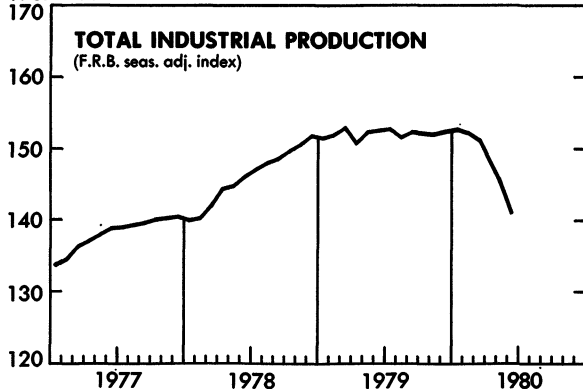
MILLIONS OF SHORT TONS



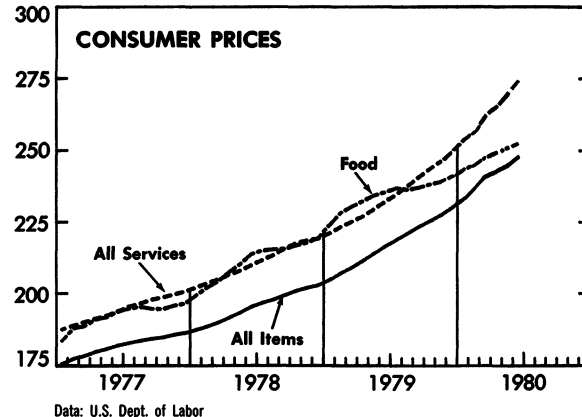
