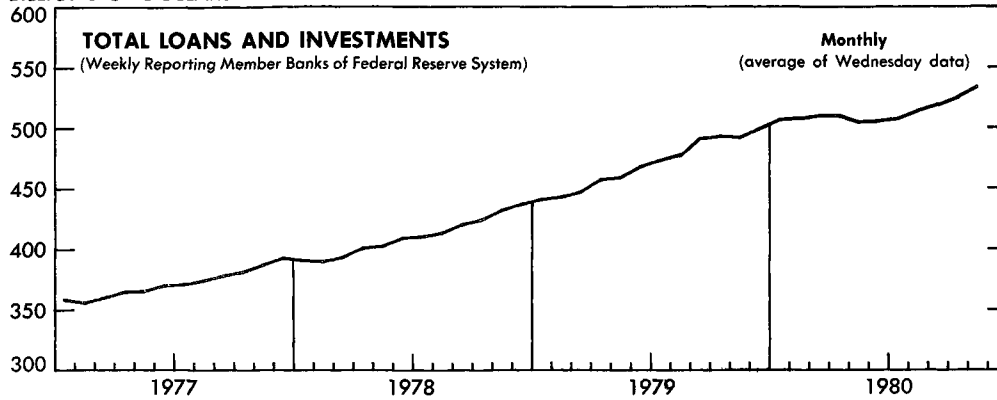

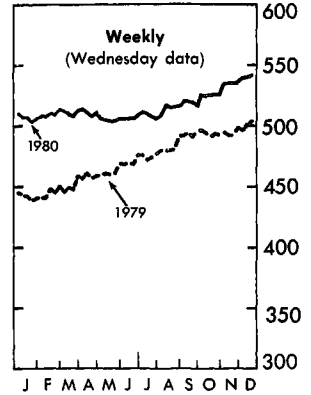

BILLIONS OF DOLLARS

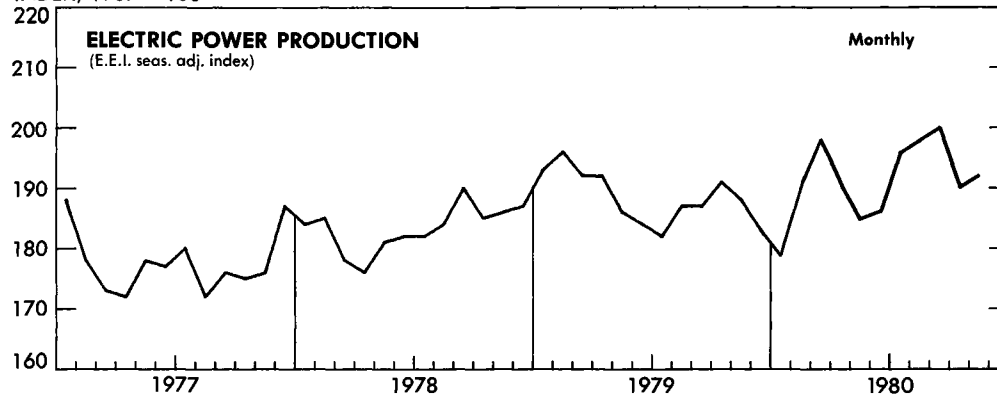

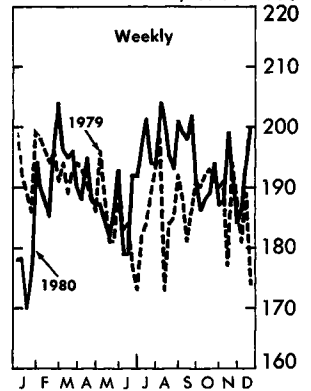


INDEX, 1967=100

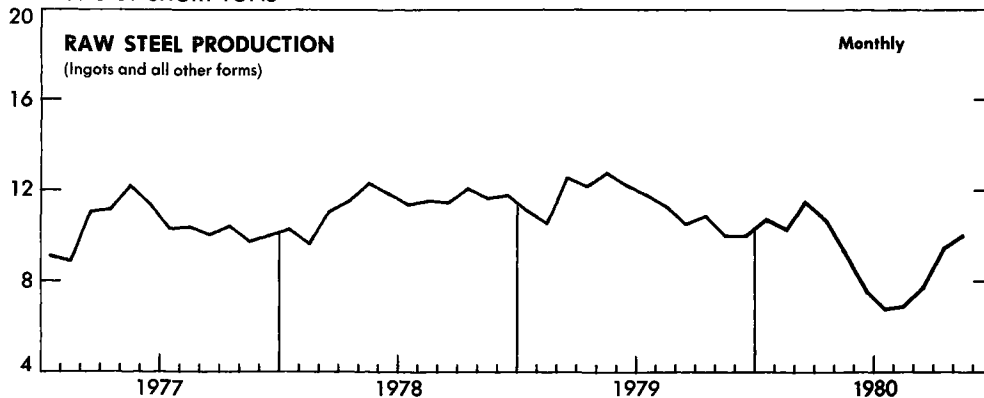

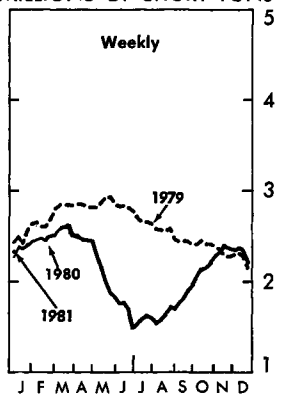


MILLIONS OF SHORT TONS
