This geographical distribution of bank deposits in the United States by counties, States, Federal Reserve districts, and standard metropolitan areas was compiled through the cooperation of Federal banking supervisory agencies, the Federal Reserve Banks, and the State bank supervisory authorities. The Comptroller of the Currency obtained the data for national banks and banks in the District of Columbia, the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System and the Federal Reserve Banks obtained those for State member banks, and the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation obtained those for nonmember banks. State bank supervisory authorities cooperated in obtaining data for noninsured banks. Preparation of the data for mechanical tabulation was accomplished in part by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation and in part by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System; final tabulations were made at the Board's offices.

The main body of the report shows the demand and time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations and total deposits in all banks in the continental United States (commercial, mutual savings, and other types combined) by counties, States, and Federal Reserve districts, on June 23, 1958. In addition there are two supplementary sections: (1) a tabulation of the total deposits and time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations in mutual savings banks by counties, States, and Federal Reserve districts, and (2) a tabulation of the demand and time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations and of total deposits in all banks by standard metropolitan areas, as defined January 15, 1957 by the Bureau of the Census. Data for deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations by counties as of December 31, 1947, June 30, 1949, December 30, 1950, June 30, 1952, June 30, 1954, and June 30, 1956 are contained in pamphlets previously published by the Board. Future publications are contemplated on a biennial basis as of mid-year call dates.

Deposits of branches located outside of the county of the head office, or outside the metropolitan areas, have been included with figures for the counties or areas in which the branches are located, rather than with those for the area in which the head office is located. Because of these adjustments, the totals for various counties, States, and Federal Reserve districts may not agree with other tabulations classifying deposits by counties, States, and Federal Reserve districts. Minor differences occur between the State and Federal Reserve district figures in this pamphlet and other published data because of the rounding of each county's figures to the nearest thousand dollars and compiling State and Federal Reserve district totals from these rounded figures.

New York City has been treated as a single county. Cities not part of any county have been treated as separate counties and have been indicated by the word "City" after the name. Counties in which there are no deposits have been listed and the figure columns left blank. Figures for a few banking institutions were not available.
