CONDITION OF MEMBER BANKS

April 12, 1961

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These statistics are tabulated from condition reports submitted by member banks following each official call, a minimum of three of which are required by law each year. The Comptroller of the Currency tabulates the national bank reports and publishes the results in the *Abstract of Reports of Condition of National Banks*. The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System tabulates the reports of State member banks and publishes the combined statistics of national and State member banks in the *Member Bank Call Report*.

Member banks are classified according to their reserve requirements as central reserve city banks, reserve city banks, or nonreserve city ("country") banks. A member bank that has an office in a central reserve city is classified as a central reserve city bank; a member bank that has an office in a reserve city, but not in a central reserve city, is classified as a reserve city bank; a member bank that does not have an office in a reserve or central reserve city is classified as a country bank. However, some banks in outlying sections of central reserve cities have permission to maintain the reserves required of reserve city banks or country banks; and some banks in outlying sections of reserve cities have permission to maintain the reserves required of country banks. Condition reports of member banks are tabulated in accordance with the reserve classifications of the banks. Since a member bank that has two or more offices, whether in the same city or in different cities, submits a consolidated condition report, the report is tabulated according to a single location (that of the bank's head office, unless it has a branch in a city where banks are subject to higher reserve requirements).

Beginning with data for April 12, 1961 the deposits schedule was revised to provide the following new items: (1) demand and time deposits due to mutual savings banks, (2) savings deposits, in the time category, and (3) for both demand and time deposits, amounts due to foreign governments and official institutions. Postal savings deposits, previously shown separately, are combined with U. S. Government time deposits.

Demand and time deposits due to mutual savings banks had previously been reported with other "interbank" accounts, and deposits in the new "foreign official" category had previously been reported largely as "foreign interbank."

The new concept of demand deposits adjusted includes all demand deposits except those of the U. S. Government and domestic commercial banks, less cash items in process of collection. This differs from the previous concept because of the inclusion of \$654 million of demand deposits due to mutual savings banks and \$1,595 million deposits due to foreign entities (\$941 million under foreign interbank and \$654 million under foreign official). Of the latter about \$560 million had previously been classified as foreign interbank deposits, \$50 million as domestic interbank deposits, and the remainder was previously included in deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations and therefore already in demand deposits adjusted. Thus, as a result of changes in classification and definition as of April 12, 1961, demand deposits adjusted under the new concept, was approximately \$2.2 billion higher than under the previous concept.

Minor revisions in the loan classifications "to domestic and foreign banks," "other nonbank financial institutions," and "all other" resulted from more precise definitions of loans to international institutions and foreign entities. These reclassifications resulted in small decreases in loans to foreign banks and in loans to "other" nonbank financial institutions, and a corresponding small increase in "all other" loans.

The new item for "securities of Federal agencies and corporations not guaranteed by United States Government" includes amounts previously classified with "other bonds, notes, and debentures."

Data for dates prior to April 12, 1961 on the new basis are not available.

The comparability of figures for succeeding call dates is affected somewhat by changes in Federal Reserve membership, mergers, etc., and by changes in the reserve classification of cities or individual banks.




