This release contains revised and corrected figures for industrial production for the four-month period from November 1975 to February 1976. The index was recalculated for this period after discovery of internal inconsistencies caused by the introduction of a new computer program.

The revised data, while generally similar in level to those released on March 16, indicate slightly different month to month changes both in the total and in many components. Industrial production is now estimated to have increased .5 per cent in February following increases of .8 per cent in each of the preceding three months. The February increase is more widespread among consumer goods, business equipment, intermediate products and materials than previously reported. It should be noted that these revised estimates for recent months are still preliminary and are subject to change as additional data become available.

RATIO SCALE - 1967=100

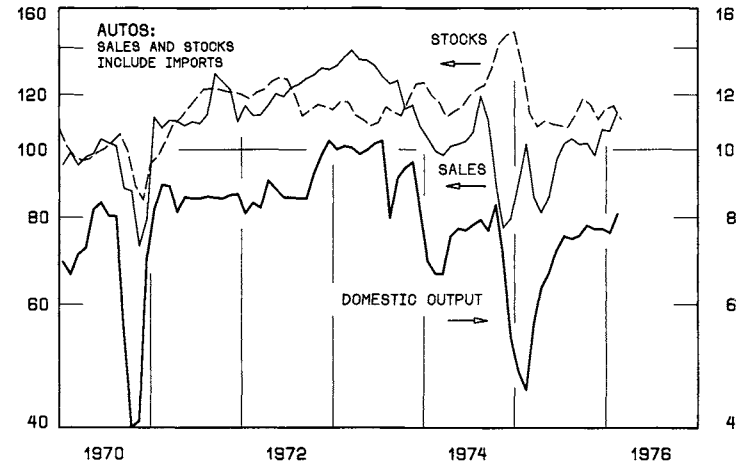
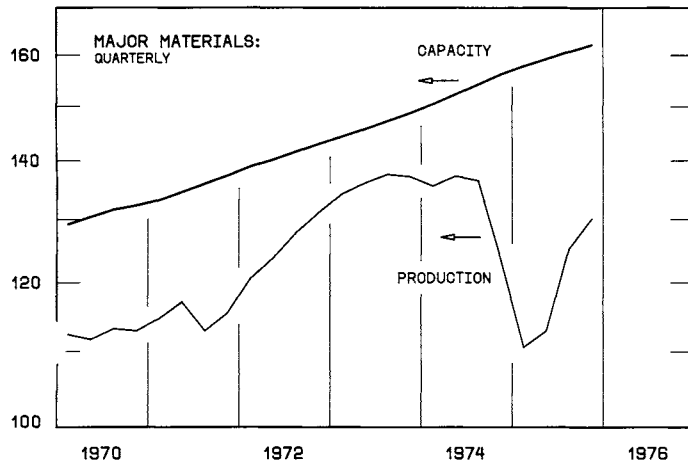
