Industrial production increased by an estimated 0.7 per cent in April reflecting widespread gains in output. Increases for the two previous months were revised upward to 1.1 per cent in February and 0.7 per cent in March, indicating a much stronger first quarter advance. Major upward revisions occurred in durable consumer goods, equipment parts, and some other materials. The April index at 122.5 per cent of the 1967 average was 11-1/2 per cent above a year earlier but about 4 per cent below the 1973 high.

Final Products. Among consumer goods, auto assemblies rose sharply in April to an annual rate of 8.6 million units, and are scheduled to increase further in May. Production of other consumer durable goods continued to advance strongly and production of consumer staples and clothing rose somewhat further. Output of business equipment also increased following gains in February and March. Output of construction products continued to expand moderately.

Materials. Production of durable materials advanced strongly reflecting increases in output of metals, equipment parts, and consumer durable parts. Nondurable goods materials rose somewhat further.

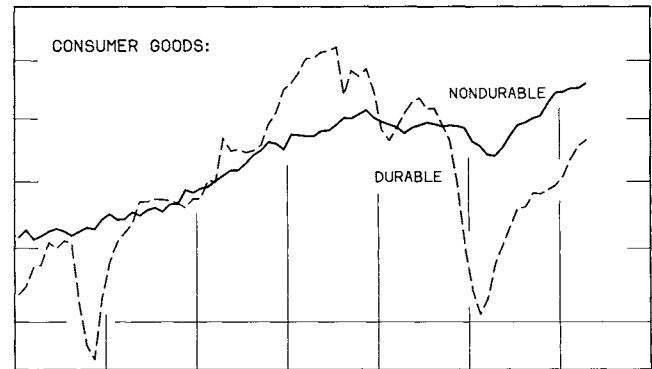

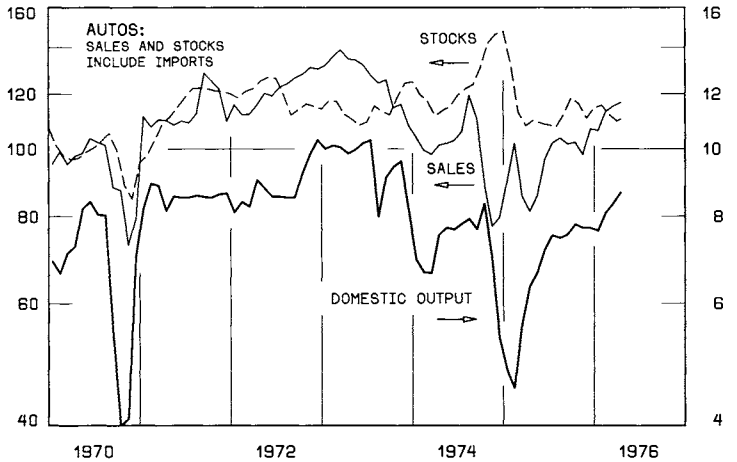
