## RBTAIL FURSITURE REPORT FOR MY 1942

Furniture store sales in May 1942 were 18 per cent belon the corresponding month lest year, reflecting a marked deoline in instalment purchases, whioh make up about three-fourthe of total sales. Cash sales, representing a much larger proportion of total sales now than a yeur ago. increased 26 per cent. Credit sales other than instalment showed little change. Inventories increased considerably over the year period and the the end of rey excseded a six months' supply at the Yay rate of sales as oompared with a four months supply a year ago.

Accounts receivable at the end of yay were substantially below those reported in 1941, while collections during the month were 17 per oent higher then a year ago.
