Instaliment sales were maintained at a low level and caich ailles contimed ir-large vaivee. There were sall decreases frcm a month ago for;both accounte reendrable and collections.

Inventories have been buslt up considermbiy in receant monthe and are now equivilent to about eight months suppily at the current rate of sale as compared with four and one-half in July 1941. The 'increase in the inventory-sales ratio is attributable in part to the substantial decline in monthily sales volume.
