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\text { RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR OCTOBER } 1942
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Retail furniture store sales showed considerably more than the usual seasonal rise from September to October, reflecting substantial increases in all types of transactions. Despite the expansion in instalment sales, they were 6 per cent below those for October 1941. Charge account sales were more than 10 per cent and cash sales about 64 per cent above the corresponding month last year.

Inventorics declined further in October to less than five and onehalf months' supply at the current rate of sale; compared with five months' supply in October 1941.

Instalment accounts receivable continued to decline at about the same rate as in Septcmber, and by the end of October were 31 per cent below those for the corresponding month of 1941. Collections on instalment accounts in October rose 11 per cent from the preceding month, bringing the ratio of collections to receivables to 18 per cent, an increase of 2.4 points over the Septerber ratio. The corresponding ratio for charge accounts showed little change from the high September figure of 64 per cent.
