## RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR JANUARY 1946

Furniture store sales declined substantially in January, but were +2 per cent above the year-ago level. Both cash and instalment sales were reduced sharply, and were considerably above those last year. Charge-account sales in January amounted to about four-fifths of the December volume, and were up 26 per cent over the year-period.

Inventories increased five per cent during the month, and at the end of January were 11 per cent larger than in the corresponding month in 1945. On January 31, stocks on hand amounted to about three and one-half months' supply at the current rate of sale, as compared with approximately four and one-half months' supply at the end of January a year earlier.

Instalment accounts receivable decreased five per cent in January, but were eight per cent larger than a year ago. Collections on instalment accounts increased slightly, and the collection ratio was unchanged at the December level of 24 per cent. These accounts continued to be collected in approximately seven months, as compared with about eight and one-half months in January last year.
