## RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR MAY 1946

Rethil furniture store sales rose 6 per cent in May, reflecting 'seasonal ciains in toth oash ant credit sales. Cash and chnrgc-account sales were in considerably larger volume than $n$ year earlier, while instalment cales were nearly ane-half grenter than in the corresionding month of 1345.
$\therefore \quad$ Inventories increased 7 per cent during Moy and mere in 22 pre ont from the lox lovel of last year. At the end of the month they mounted to about three months' supoly int the current rote of sale, as compared with neorly foir mionths' supply on May $31,1945$.

Instalment necounts receimeble incressed slightly during yoy. hit at the pend of the month were about one-fifth higher than a year earlier. Colloctions incroased 4 per cent, resulting in neollection ratio of 28 oer efnt, the enme os in the preceding month. These nccounts were outstandine approximetelv six monthe, " somewhat shorter period than the average for 'iny 1945.
