Inventories, which usualiy are not buitit up, at this time of the year, decreased 3 per cent in jure. Nevertheless, they wers about ope--; siyth above the 967 level, representing slightly more than four months' supply at the current; rate of saie.

Irstalment accounts receivable at the end of June nerest per cent higher than on May 31 but nearly one-half again as large as on the: corresponding date of the preceding year. Collections on these aecounta . $_{1}$. were slightly accelerated, amounting to 20 per cent of the amount outstanding on June 1 , as compared with 19 per cent in the three preceding months. At the currient ratë of repayment, instalment accounts would be liquidated in about nine months.
