RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR MAY 1950

Total sales at retail furniture stores increased 13 per cent in Lay and were 7 per cent above those in the corresponding month of 1949. Credit sales rose about one-tenth during the month while cash sales showed a somewhat greater increase. The Nay rate of expansion was sinilar for both instalment and charge-account credit sales. Sales volume was up over the year-period by 7 per cent for instalment transactions and 9 per cent for charge-account business, but cash sales continued in about the same volume as in the preceding year.

Instalment accounts receivable at the end of May showed little change from those of a month earlier but were more than one-fourth greater than on the corresponding date last year. Coılections on instalment accounts increased 5 per cent in lay and the ratio of these collections to accounts receivable on the first of the month was 10 per cent, the same as in April. At the current rate of repayment instalment accounts would be liquidated in about 18 months, approximately three months longer than a year earlier.

Inventories declined slightly in lay but were 5 per cent larger than on the corresponding date of 1949. Stock on hand on May 31 represented about four montis supply at the current rate of sale.
