#### RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR JULY 1951

Total sales at furniture stores declined 10 per cent in July, a month during which decreases are usual. Cash and charge-account sales were 9 per cent below their respective June figures, while instalment sales showed a decrease of 11 per cent. The 24 per cent drop in total sales from the previous July reflected sharp year-to-year declines in credit sales, particularly instalment sales, from the high volume of sales reached during the buying wave of July 1950.

A 3 per cent decline in instalment accounts receivable during July continued the downward movement of recent months. At the month-end instalment balances were 9 per cent below the year-ago figure. Collections on instalment accounts were down 6 per cent from June and amounted to about 11 per cent of first-of-month balances, the same collection ratio as in the preceding month.

Inventories at furniture stores were reduced by 4 per cent during July, but at the month-end were 29 per cent above the level of a year ago. Stocks on hand at the end of July represented about 6 months' supply at the current rate of sales. This compares with less than 4 months' supply a year earlier.
