RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR HARCH 1952

The exfansion in furniture store sales in Farch was somewhat less than usual for this time of year．licathly volume was up 5 per cent from $F$ Foruairy，but off 6 per cent frum ifarch a year ago．The month－to－month increase resulted from incresses of 2 per cent and 8 per cent in cash and instalment sales，respectively；charge－ account saies in llarch were unchanged from February．

Instalment accounts outstanding on liarch 31 were down slightly from both a month ago and a year ago．Collections on in－ stalment accounts increased 7 per cent in larch，but were 5 per cent below those of the same month last year．
ieerchandise on hand as of liarch 31 was equal to about five month＇s supply at the current rate of sale．The retail value of these inventories was 4 per cent above the end of February，but was 16 per cent belor Liarch a year ão．
