RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR AUGUST 1953

Total sales at furniture stores in August increased 8 per cent from the preceding month, but continued below a year ago. The increase from a month ago reflected gains of 8 per cent in instalment and charge-account sales and 4 per cent in cash sales. Compared with August of last year, instalment sales were down 4 per cent, charge-account sales 5 per cent, and cash sales 2 per cent.

Instalment accounts receivable at furniture stores again showed practically no change during the month, but on August 31 were 8 per cent above the corresponding date last year. Collections on these accounts decreased 1 per cent from the preceding month.

The retail value of furniture store inventories was reduced slightly during August to a month-end level approximating that of a year earlier. Stocks on hand amounted to about a 4 months' supply at the August rate of sales.
